Saturday program:

8.20am: Meet Wendy Williams (RMFN Project Officer) in the foyer of the Cable Beach Club Resort.

8.45 -9.30am: Enjoy local arts, crafts, produce, busking and the atmosphere of the markets in the grounds of the historic Courthouse.

9.30 -10.05am: Travel to Old Broome Lockup Gallery. This historic building was Broome's first prison and has been converted to an art gallery showcasing indigenous art, boab nut carvings and didgeridoos. Take the opportunity to try playing a didgeridoo.

10.10 -10.30am: Enjoy the amazing photography and video footage of the creatures of the Giant Tides in Roebuck Bay. This bay carries more biodiversity than any other bay in the world.

10.30 -11.00am: Stopover at Town Beach, which was the site of the Japanese Air Raid and view footage of this tragic day in Broome history. Take photos of the red pindan cliffs and the turquoise waters of Roebuck Bay.

11.00am: Travel to Fusion Herbs café and on the way view a video explaining the history of cultured pearling in the Kimberley.

11.30 -12.30pm: Fusion Herbs Café is part of the Open Garden Scheme and is having an open day, enjoy the gardens and a delicious lunch including fresh herbs and vegetables from their own organic gardens.

12.30pm: Return to Cable Beach Resort for leisure time until the afternoon program commences.

2.30 - 4.00pm: Meet Wendy Williams in the foyer for a brisk walk to visit Malcolm Douglas's crocodile park, where the crocodile's feeding frenzy takes place at 3pm.

4.00pm: Return to Cable Beach resort for free time.
